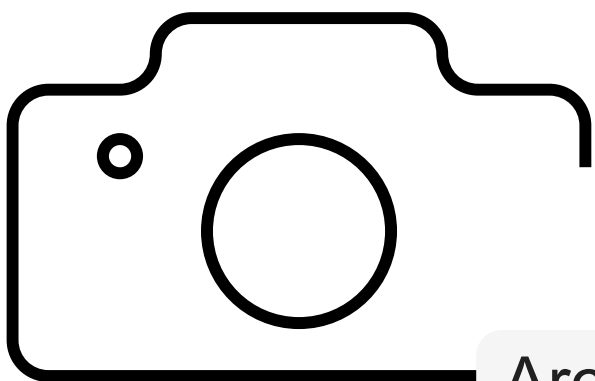

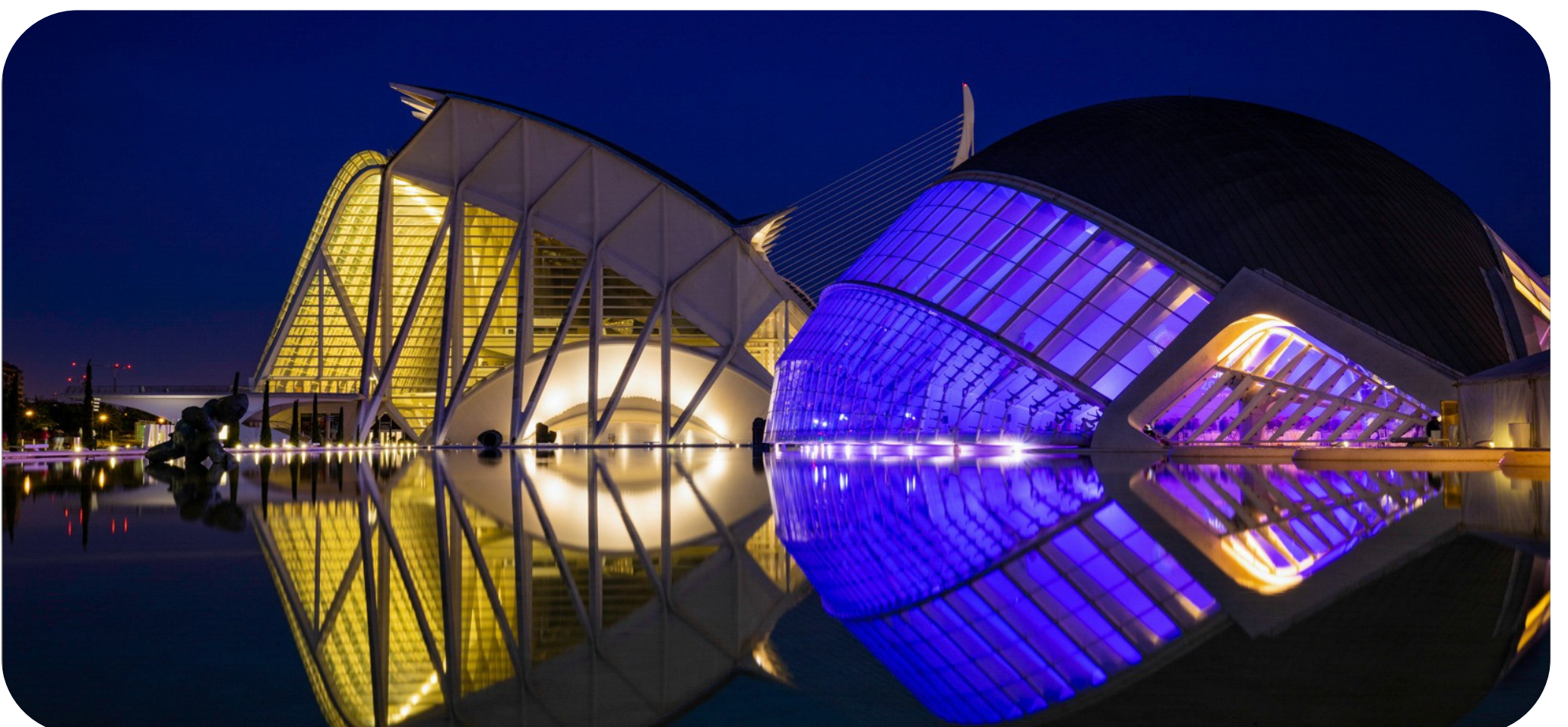
VALENCIA - SPAIN

THE CITY OF ARTS AND SCIENCES

A veritable photographers' playground! It is the magnus opus of Valencian-born world-renowned innovative architect **SANTIAGO CALATRAVA**



For this 5-night workshop, we will be based at a nearby Barcelo hotel with easy access to this cultural and architectural complex. These surreal buildings are surrounded by shallow pools, which lend themselves to capturing both amazing reflections and more detailed, abstract architectural images. We will shoot for several hours at dawn and dusk every day to take full advantage of the blue hour to capture the warmth of the illuminated buildings against the inky blue skies

As the sun rises, interesting shadows are cast by the architectural details and these can create stunning black and white compositions. The area is also a great opportunity for those interested in infra red photograph

We will also venture into the old city to visit the Mercado Central, the biggest indoor market in Europe as well as La Llotja (the historic silk exchange) with its Hall of Columns and courtyard of orange trees.

We will wander the colourfully graffitied streets of Valencia and visit the Gothic cathedral of San Nicolas with its heavily adorned baroque ceiling dubbed the “Sistine chapel of Valencia”.

A day outing to El Cabanyal is also on the cards...an area reminiscent of Cuba for street photography. And depending on whether we get good skies we will travel by bus to the Albufera National Park for sunset.

We will also take a guided tour of the magnificent Opera house which has unique opportunities for architectural abstract images.

There will be some down time during the midday for self exploration or editing in the communal areas.

The hotel has a rooftop bar and pool with great views of the City of Arts and Sciences .I will be on hand to assist with all things photographic.



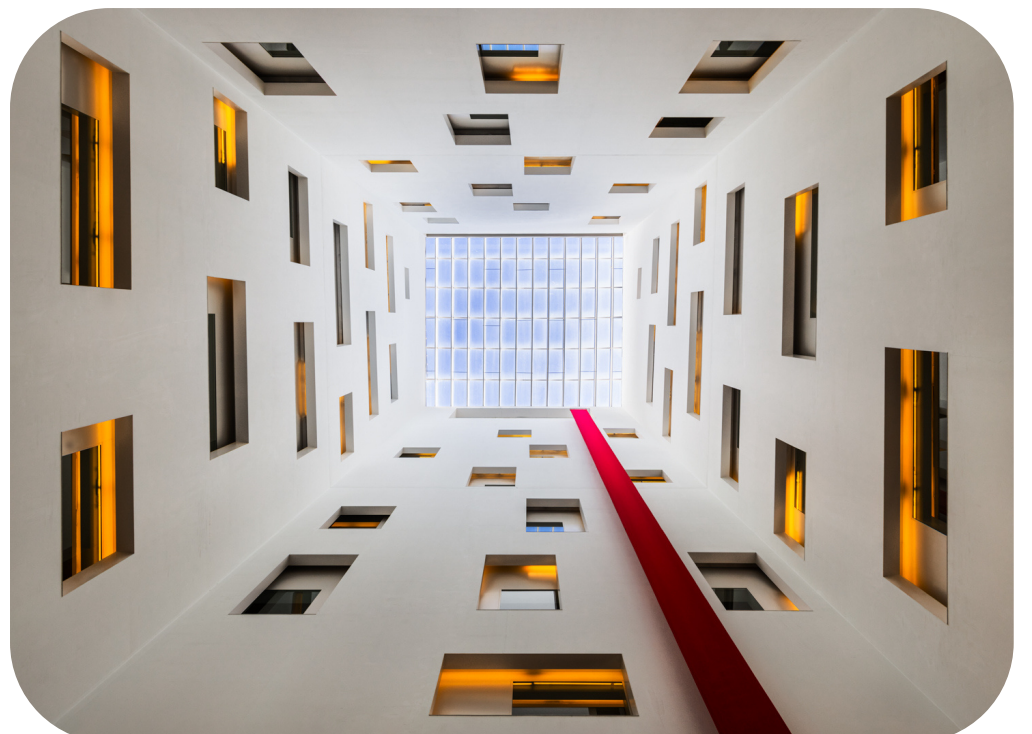
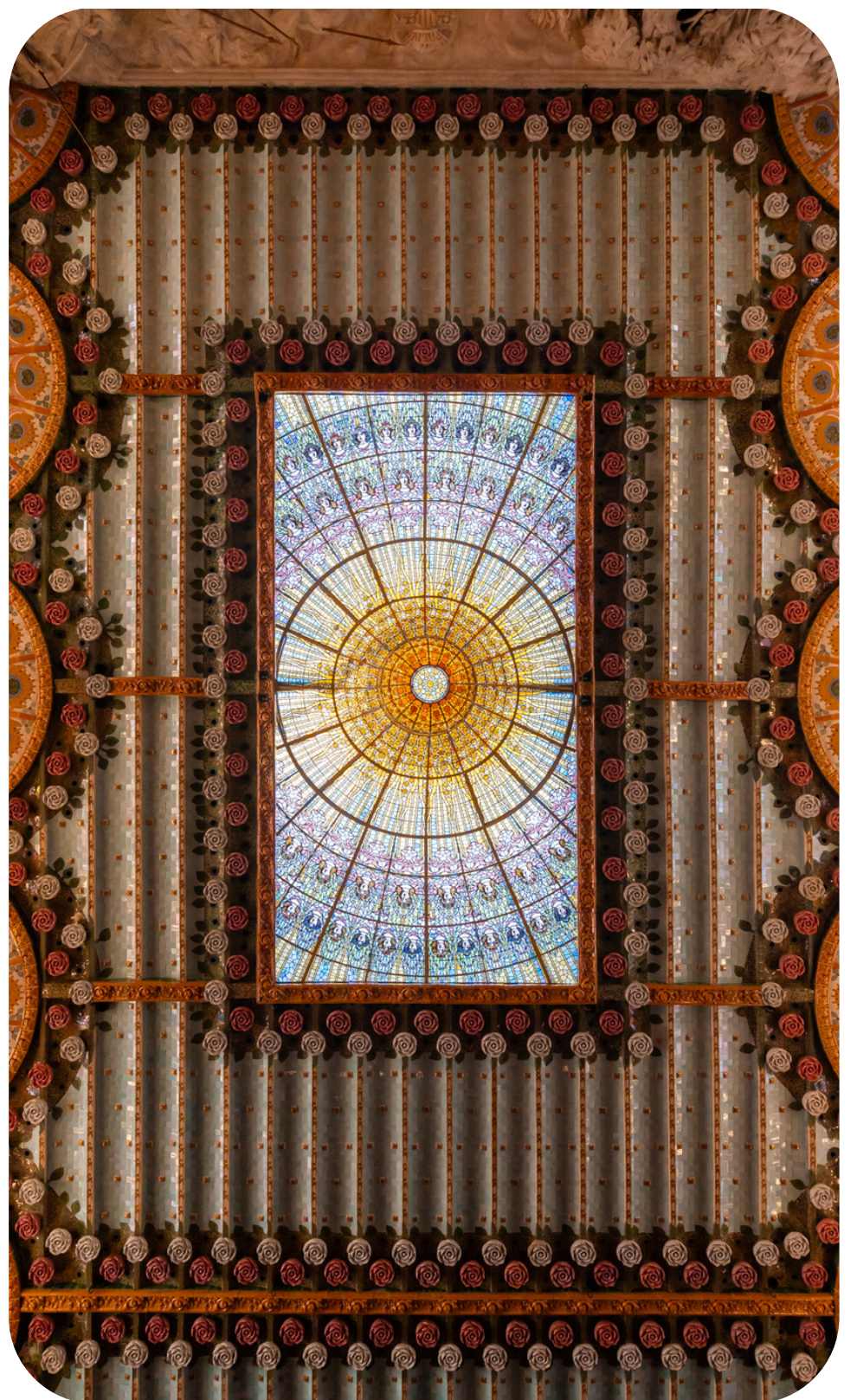

We will explore the extraordinary vision of Antoni Gaudí, whose organic forms, intricate details and imaginative use of colour transformed Barcelona's skyline.

From the flowing façades of Casa Batlló and La Pedrera to the grandeur of the Sagrada Família and the playful mosaics of Park Güell, photographers will have the opportunity to capture the beauty of Catalan Art Nouveau.

The tour will be a visual journey through light, texture, symmetry and creative expression.

THE CITY OF ARCHITECTURAL POETRY

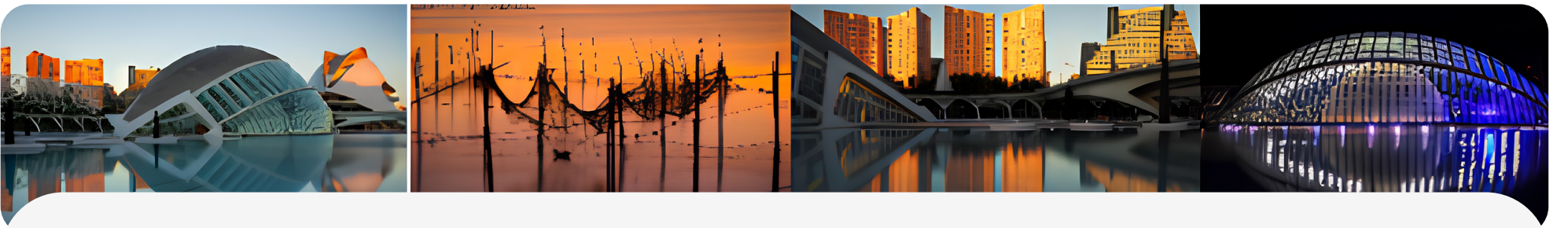
Our base for the Barcelona experience is the stylish Motel One, perfectly positioned near the atmospheric Gothic Quarter, where narrow medieval streets, hidden courtyards, historic squares and vibrant local life provide endless opportunities for street, architectural and night photography.

During the day, we will travel by taxi to Barcelona's iconic UNESCO World Heritage Sites, exploring Antoni Gaudí's architectural masterpieces.

This carefully planned approach minimises travel time, maximises photographic opportunities, and allows us to experience both the historic soul and artistic brilliance of one of Europe's most captivating cities.

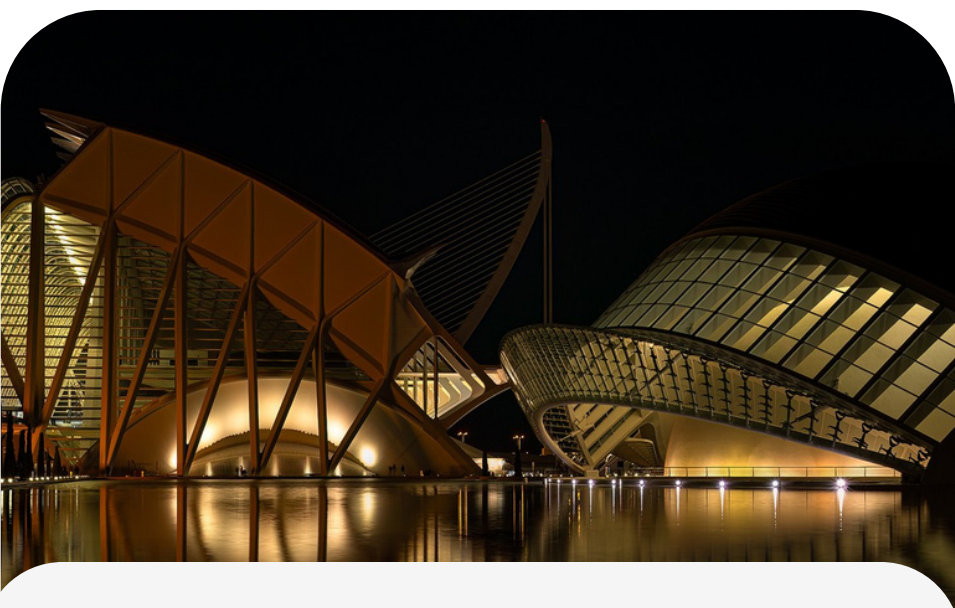
“When Richard and I heard that Kim was organizing a trip to photograph the incredible city of Valencia, we immediately booked our place on her guided tour.

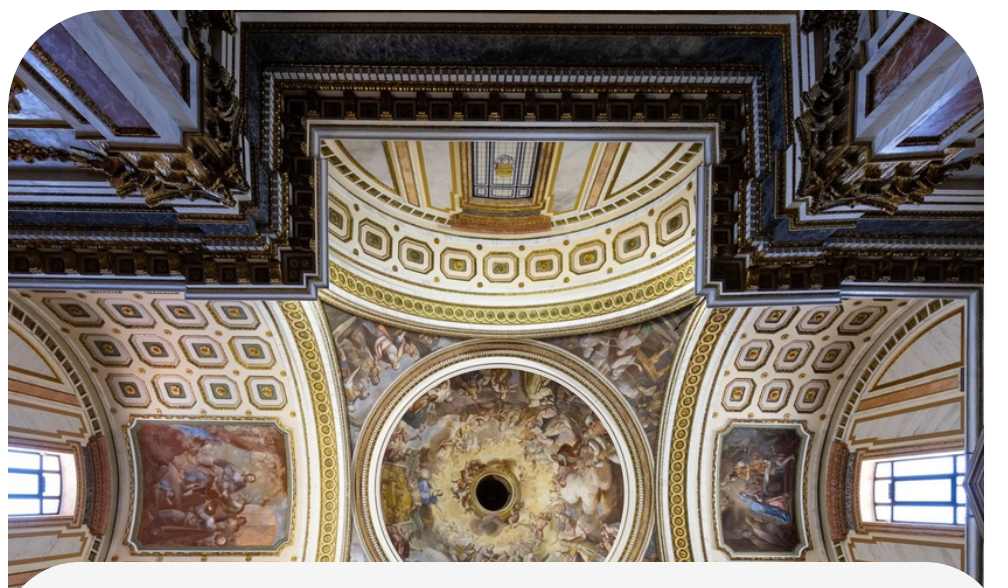
We had such a brilliant time that we are joining Kim on another of her photographic guided tours – this time to shoot the misty vistas of the ancient city of Venice.”

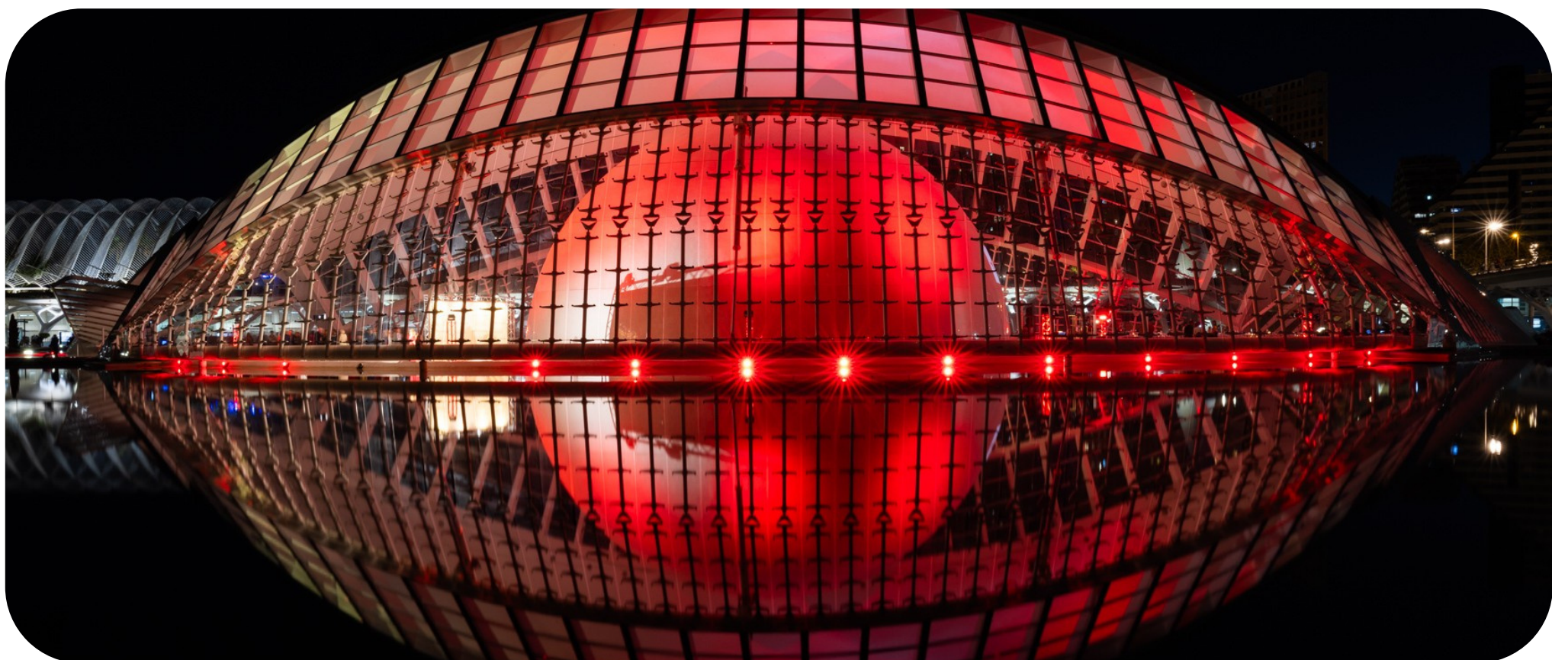
